Fall Application

Students applying for the fall semester must submit **completed** application materials to the School of Nursing by February 15th. The School of Nursing will accept applications for the fall semester no earlier than January 15th. Transfer students applying to the School of Nursing for Fall must be admitted to Edgewood College no later than January 9th.

Spring Application

Students applying for the spring semester must submit **completed** application materials to the School of Nursing by September 15th. The School of Nursing will accept applications for the spring semester no earlier than August 15th. Transfer students applying to the School of Nursing for Spring must be admitted to Edgewood College no later than August 14th.

Minimum Admission Requirements for Application to the School of Nursing

1. Students must be admitted to Edgewood College prior to applying to the School of Nursing
2. Completion of Edgewood College Math 101 or 111, English 110, COMMS (Speech) 101 and Philosophy (Logic) 101*
3. Completion of CHEM 110 and completion or current enrollment in Biology 155 with a minimum grade of C*
4. Completion or current enrollment in two of the following courses: Biology 210, Biology 211, Biology 312 with a minimum grade of C*
5. A minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.75 and minimum math/science grade point average of 2.75
6. Upon admission to program, CNA certification is required before enrollment in Nursing Courses

**Transfer equivalencies are also acceptable. All math and science courses must be completed within the last five years, or as part of a BA/BS degree earned within the last five years, to be considered current.*

Application Process

1. Successfully apply and be admitted to Edgewood College by specified date (January 9th for Fall applicants, August 14th for Spring Applicants).
2. Complete the Application to Nursing Program.
3. Current students must attach a student copy (unofficial, may be printed from Express) of their **current Edgewood College transcript**.
4. Post-baccalaureate* and Transfer students (or Edgewood Students who enrolled in classes at other institutions) must attach a **current transfer credit evaluation** obtained through the Edgewood College Registrar's Office reporting final grades for all courses taken elsewhere.
5. Submit the completed application form, unofficial Edgewood student transcripts, credit evaluation (if applicable), activities and work list to the Nursing School Advisor, Quinn Mullikin, by the February 15th or September 15th deadline for applications (only completed applications will be accepted). –If currently taking courses at another institution, include unofficial course schedule/enrollment information in order for Nursing to determine if pre-requirement courses are in progress.
6. Admission is competitive. Forty-two students are accepted to the program each admission cycle. Therefore, students meeting minimum requirements are not guaranteed admission into the nursing major.

**Post-baccalaureate students accepting admission to the traditional nursing program will not be eligible to apply to Edgewood College's accelerated nursing program.*
